

PESHAWAR INCIDENT

On the 1st day of the Holy month of Shaban, in March 2022, a heinous act was carried out at the Friday prayers in Peshawar.

Upholding the goal of the organization, we launched a campaign to offer educational support to the children of the martyrs.

With the support of our donors, we were able to collect a good amount of money and fund many of these orphans' educational requirements.

As of the academic year 2022-2023, 20 students orphaned by this blast are already under the sponsorship of HOPE Foundation. As of academic year 2023-2024, there will be a total of 55 orphaned students sponsored by HOPE Foundation.



MONTH OF RAMADHAN

Similar to last year, H.O.P.E. Foundation once again arranged for food relief to feed the poor and needy people throughout various areas of Pakistan, especially in remote villages. We provided one month's worth of ration packages to communities and homes to fulfill their immediate ration needs during the month of blessed Ramadhan 2022. This year, we reached a total of 1,029 beneficiaries.

QURBANI

Each year, H.O.P.E. Foundation runs the campaign for collection of funds prior to Eid-ul-Adha. With the collected funds, H.O.P.E. Foundation purchases livestock on behalf of the donors and fulfills the religious rites and duties by distributing meat amongst the neediest and most deserving in the remote regions of Pakistan.

With your help, H.O.P.E. Foundation's 2022 Qurbani campaign was able to raise \$16,450.53, through which over 3,953 beneficiaries were reached. These are the families whose malnourished members are unable to acquire the day-to-day necessities, let alone, incorporate meat into their diets. However, through your generous donations, the families could enjoy meat, even if for once in the year, on the joyous day of Eid-ul-Adha.



SCHOLARSHIP AND EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT

In 2022, H.O.P.E. Foundation raised a total of \$517,022 for scholarships and educational support.

Through the funds, 3,826 school students were supported through 43 institutions in various regions of Pakistan. In addition, another 476 students of various disciplines received academic scholarships directly for higher education, with a total of 4,302 students being supported during the year.

The schools are not ordinary schools – rather, these schools and the students within belong to the most geographically and demographically disadvantaged areas of Pakistan. These regions historically have not had any establishment of educational facilities, nor had the norm of children enrolling in education.

As such, H.O.P.E. Foundation opted to take upon the responsibility of establishing educational institutions, infrastructure and a new mindset within the civilians of these regions, such that the leaders of tomorrow & generations to come are equipped with the most important tool of all: Education. With your continuous help, support and donations, H.O.P.E. Foundation continues to support schools and higher education students of various disciplines.


