



PROJECTS OVERVIEW

RAMADHAN RATION

As is done annually, H.O.P.E. Foundation once again arranged for and distributed ration packs created with one month supply per family. Many remote villages around Pakistan were covered, including those in cities like Karachi, Quetta, Peshawar, Rawalpindi, Lahore and Hyderabad to Sibi, Thar, Jafarabad, Jacobabad, Layyah and Parachinar and more.

The ration packs included the list below, and were successfully distributed to over **1260 families**.

These packs typically include the following items. One ration pack is enough for four people for one month.

- · Flour
- ·Rice
- · Oil
- · Chana dal
- · Moong dal
- · Channa
- · Sugar
- · Gramflour
- · Tea
- · Jam
- · Rooh Afza
- · Dates
- · Salt
- ·Spices



The distribution of the above ration packages usually begins just before the beginning of the month of Ramadhan and continues till after Eid. Fitra is also collected by the organization and distributed as per the Sharia requirements.

These donations helped to put a smile on the face of so many needy children and adults alike, a moment of joy for them once again with your qurbani.

EDUCATION

As our core mandate, the H.O.P.E. Foundation focuses on providing access to education for those who would usually not have this access. In addition to contributing towards the school fees of the students, the donations also help to maintain a certain standard of education and facilities offered to these children.

In areas where there has historically been almost no education and no facilities, this year we have supported **46 schools** through various means, including:

- · Providing training to teachers and staff
- · Services and assistance for staff, teachers and students
- · Infrastructure in the schools, including water, hygiene and sanitation
- · Overall facilities to help students achieve a good standard of all-rounded education

Keeping in mind the COVID pandemic, all the schools were also equipped with the required tools to ensure the health and safety of all students and staff, including masks, daily temperature checks, sanitizers and gloves. Vaccination drives were also conducted in some schools.

We have helped a total of **4,500 students** get access to good education by providing their school fees, uniforms and books.

Over the year, we were able to improve several things in a number of schools, including providing facilities for sports and recreation, organizing community events during special occasions, award functions, as well as getting specialized speakers and trainers where there was an opportunity for students to gain more information and knowledge.

VIRTUAL FUNDRAISER
