COVID-19 CAMPAIGN

The COVID-19 outbreak has reformed the lives of everyone around the world. As the fight to contain the spread continues, self-isolation is the primary preventative measure taken by the governments of all countries. However, self-isolation does not come without its hurdles.

For those who struggle to put food on the table and a roof above the head of their families under normal circumstances, the unexpected layoffs, no external source of income or provision of relief is an agony too much to bear.

As such, H.O.P.E. Foundation Canada requests your help in raising funds for provision of essentials to individuals and families in self-isolation facing these dire circumstances. Your funds will ensure these individuals and families are safely provided with everyday necessities and are curbed from putting their own and their community's health & wellbeing at risk by pursuing these items against the recommended measures.

We are actively reaching out to needy families who are having difficulty in getting basic necessities during this COVID-19 pandemic. We as Canadians are helping one another in these difficult times, while our government and medical community works tirelessly to alleviate the issue.











PROJECTS OVERVIEW

Muslim Women of York Region

Through the Muslim Women Of York Region we distributed basic necessities to individuals and families within the GTA who were in need the most. H.O.P.E. Foundation assisted the organization's requirement to fulfill basic food and groceries support to community members. Muslim Women of York Region provided aid to around 25 families through ration bags which contained various items for daily use. These bags included enough supplies to last a couple of weeks during the COVID-19 peak impact phase.

Islamic Shia Athna-Asheri Jammat of Toronto (ISIJ)

Phrough ISIJ, a major mosque situated at 9000 Bathurst street, Thornhill Ontario and a charitable registered organization, H.O.P.E. provided funds which were utilized in the distribution of food supplies during the month of Ramadan to over 2500 families. Supplies were delivered to families homes to encourage social distancing and staying home. Majority of those that received aid were elders and families in need during the pandemic impacts high season.

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H.O.P.E.

HOPE foundation has served over 60 families/individuals who were in desperate need of day to day groceries and basic house hold necessities. This was a great support to those who had lost their jobs, before the government funding execution. There were many individuals who could not qualify to take advantage from Government funding. Hence, having support through H.O.P.E. Foundation, was a life line for them at a time when all other sources were dried up for living.

Shelter Support

H.O.P.E. also helped an individual find shelter, as the individual had lost hope in being able to continue renting their place. Their situation was impacted due to COVID-19/health and job prospects.

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Students

H.O.P.E. also supported a few students, both local and international (residing in Canada) who were unable to buy their basic groceries and had been hopeless due to the COVID-19 impact.
H.O.P.E. Foundation had extended help to those students during a difficult period of their life.






FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

TOTAL COLLECTION OF FUNDS


Help Orphans and Promote Education Foundation collected a total of \$31,457.00 in funds for COVID-19.

FUTURE GOALS

We are still working with people and organizations who are actively supporting needy shelter in the GTA. These organization support individuals who are in need of food and have no place to live during this Pandemic, those still living under difficult circumstances and those that currently do not qualify for any ongoing government financial support. We are helping them through Women of York Region, on a weekly basis to supply them with raw food which they can utilize. We are also actively working with Seniors, to provide them with their day to day necessities.



OUR VOLUNTEERS

During the COVID-19 pandemic, we reached out within our community to get volunteers who would act as essential workers in aiding needy families that were heavily affected by the pandemic. There were about 30+ volunteers that signed up to help within the Greater Toronto Area (GTA), all spread out over various districts, with a main lead assigned in each district. Upon request, the leads would be contacted for delivery of food essential to the needy families.
